To date, literature searches have been completed, level 1 (title and abstract) screening has been completed and level 2 (full reference) screening has begun. Preparations for level 3 (data extraction) are in progress.

The group is using *Distiller SR* systematic review management software, which is proving very helpful in managing a dispersed review group. A short communication about the review will be given at AMEE 2013.

We anticipate that the review will be submitted for publication in June 2014.
