Summary of Review Status:

- Electronic searches have been completed,
- Grey literature and hand searches are in progress (approximately half way done)
- Title and full text screening of searches to date have identified 66 papers that meet the inclusion criteria
- Authors of included studies have been contacted
- Data extraction has been completed by the 1st reviewer and half of the 20% checks by a second reviewer have been completed
- Quality assessment has been performed on all included papers by 2 independent reviewers
- Data analysis is in progress
- We have presented on the initial stages of the review at AMEE 2014 and the preliminary results at the Canadian Conference on Medical Education 2015 and at AMEE 2015
