

Remediation interventions for undergraduate and postgraduate medical learners with academic difficulties: a BEME systematic review

We are almost done screening 16520 articles, and have up to now included 92 articles in the review. Data extraction will be completed for those 92 articles by Monday, and we will start to analyse our database in the upcoming weeks.

On December 18th, we have a consensus meeting with the reviewers. We will then work on qualitative analyses, synthesis of extracted evidence and manuscript redaction during the Winter, and should be able to submit a manuscript in April.
